### **Waiting List Policy**

If you do not get into your requested course choice, then the course has reached its maximum enrollment and you will automatically be placed on a waiting list. If you are waitlisted for a course, a notation will be placed on the bottom of your invoice. If a space becomes available in the course and you get into your request section, an updated invoice will be placed into your student mailbox. If you no longer want to be on a waiting list for a course, please submit a drop form. It is important that you continuously check your student mailbox for updated invoices.

After April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2008, students will be called if a space is available in a course. The student will have 24 hours to respond, or they will be removed from the waiting list and the next student will be contacted. This procedure will be followed until Friday of week two of Spring 2008 Semester.
