

**Fall 2011 School Performance Fact Sheet: MSTOM Program, Chicago
(for Fall 2011 & Winter 2012 terms)**

The following is a School Performance Fact Sheet for your information as a consumer.

(a) Completion rate: 31%*

•The completion rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates by the number of students available for graduation.

(b) Placement rate: 93%**

•The job placement rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.

•The student may obtain a list of the employment positions determined to be within the field for which a student received education and training for the calculation of job placement rates from the Director of Alumni Services.

(c) National License examination passage rates, 1st time exam takers*** (for 2 years)

(d) The college makes no claims to applicants regarding salary that may be earned after completing the program. However according to the Job Task Analysis conducted by the NCCAOM in 2008, “the Average gross income a year is less than \$60,000 per year for 70.1% of the Diplomate respondents. Twenty-one percent (21.2%) stated that they earn between \$60,000 and \$120,000 and 8.7% earn over \$121,000 per year.” ****
