PRACTICAL INFORMATION

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- · Associate degree in nursing (or higher) from an accredited institution recognized by the US Department of Education or international equivalent.
- Active, unencumbered Registered Nurse license in state or jurisdiction where the student's clinical experience in CL 520ce will occur.
- English language proficiency.

TUITION AND FEES

1. TUITION:

· Certificate: \$455/credit

2. FEES (ALL STUDENTS):

- a. Books and Supplies*: \$221
- b. Application Fee \$50 (not refundable) (fee waived for US veterans)
- c. Administrative Fee, per term \$40 (not refundable)
- d. Student Council Fee, per term **\$10** (not refundable after add/ drop period)
- e. Technology Fee, per term \$150

Students may defer current Title IV loans while enrolled in the program.

(*) The cost for textbooks and supplies is approximate, based on current requirements and prices. Students are not required to purchase textbooks and supplies from the school. Standard Fees (apply to all students).

SCHEDULE AND COURSE DELIVERY

The didactic classes are offered online, using a combination of live classes and asynchronous coursework with defined outcomes. Live classes are delivered in real time, with audio and video connection to faculty and fellow students. They are recorded in case you have to miss them.

Each program includes mandatory clinical practica. All practica are done in the student's locale. Faculty and staff support the process of each student finding their own preceptor.

We work hard to create a safe teaching/learning environment and strengthen important collegial relationships. The connection among students is comparable to that of on-site classes with the added benefit of attending from the comfort and convenience of your home.

A part-time schedule is also available.
