- Arrange alphabetically by author's last name.
- Arrange works with no author by the first significant word in the title.
- Arrange works signed "Anonymous" as though "Anonymous" were a name.

REMINDER: cite your sources to avoid plagiarism

When writing your paper, you MUST identify the source of any

- quotations
- facts
- idea or opinion that is not your own
